EMUNI University tends to make an excellent network of specialised study programmes between Euro-Mediterranean universities, mostly in the form of double and joint degrees. Study programmes will focus on topics that are priorities of the Union for the Mediterranean and will be carried out at several universities; partners of EMUNI University. The international comparability of study programmes will be ensured with respect to credits, as well as awarded scientific and professional titles.

EMUNI LABEL STUDY PROGRAMMES

In the Academic Year 2010/11, EMUNI partner universities from **France, Italy and Tunisia** in cooperation with EMUNI University will implement six 'EMUNI label' master study programmes.

Some general characteristics of 'EMUNI label' study programmes:

- study programmes will be delivered at the location of the university that will issue the degree while part of the study will be delivered at EMUNI University, Slovenia where the module Euro-Mediterranean Studies will be organised,
- language of delivery: English, French or one of the languages of the Union for the Mediterranean,
- multicultural learning environment (students and professors),
- a range of teaching methods will be applied, including face-to-face tuition, on-line instruction, project work; internship programme may also be organised,
- besides quality assurance and assessment carried out by the university responsible for the programme/degree, the innovative and intercultural aspects of study programmes will be observed and assessed by EMUNI experts.

EURO-MEDITERRANEAN STUDIES

The main aim of the module Euro-Mediterranean Studies (EMS) is to provide participants with a broad understanding of the Euro-Mediterranean region from different perspectives (economical, social, political, cultural, environmental, etc). The module will be delivered in two terms at EMUNI University in Slovenia. The module was adopted at the Senate of EMUNI University and is in the accreditation procedure at SQAA (Quality Assurance Agency for Higher Education).

Courses in the **1st term** (21 February to 12 March 2011)¹, language - EN:

- Euro-Mediterranean International Relations, 5 ECTS,
- Marine Environment of the Mediterranean Sea, 5 ECTS; in cooperation with the University of Alexandria, Egypt
- Sustainable Use and Conservation of the Mediterranean Flora, 5 ECTS; in cooperation with the University of Lisbon, Portugal
- Geographical Perspectives and Tourist Regions, 5 ECTS; in cooperation with the University of Maribor, Slovenia and CMU/University of Bari, Italy

Courses in the **2nd term** (4 to 16 April 2011)¹, language - FR:

- Euro-Mediterranean International Relations, 5 ECTS
- External Cooperation and EUROMED, 5 ECTS; in cooperation with the CMU/University of Bari, Italy

¹single course will be delivered for at least 15 students
